BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

This project will convert the existing high voltage street lighting systems to low voltage by replacing 88 streetlights and 140 fixtures/lamps with LED fixtures. Work also includes the installation of new conduit, pullboxes, and wires. In addition, the project will include the installation of technology to provide real-time reporting of light outages/failures. The project is in the vicinity of Southeast Los Angeles and Wilmington.

This project is financed by SB1 (Senate Bill 1 for Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Act - Local Streets and Roads Program) and the Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles (MICLA)

This project will not result in an increase to existing Street Lighting Maintenance Assessments and therefore a Proposition 218 assessment ballot proceeding is not required.

THE CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION REQUIRED FOR AWARD IS **"C-10" or "A"**.
